Highlighted and reflected on 2021. Moved to 2022, acknowledged 2 students leaders in
attendance, acknowledged PTA and Chair

Challenges 2021, teacher shortage resulting in existing teacher pick up work load, which in
turn put pressure on well being

Due to teacher shortage, subjects had to be reduced to 5, cap on year 9 students' numbers.
Operational budget - which did not increase worked with PTA and smaller parent group
who put together a proposal to MFEM for increase budget

Support from Chair and PTA for pay parity, which is a win. Thank you to key members of
PTA . Resulted in Teachers felt valued. 3 year contracted teachers roll over to 5
years. Lowest staff turnover.

NCEA result held up well.

New changes, so teachers have been working to hard

5 staff lost, 2021

9 staff hired in 2022 in particular 7 cook islanders with 1 new beginning teacher, young
student leader now turn to teaching.
