Enrolment Agreement

It is Tereora College’s wish that all staff have the opportunity to work with parents and caregivers to ‘raise-up a child’ who will respect and honor all others, become ‘excellent in citizenship’ and make knowledgeable leaders for tomorrow.

Upon enrolment:

- I / We agree that my child will wear the correct school uniform and abide by the rules and regulations and discipline procedures of Tereora College
- I / We agree that we have read and will abide by the Standard Dress Code Requirement
- I / We give permission for the College to use any image / publication showing my son’s / daughter’s work or self
- I / We agree that non uniform items can be confiscated and that Tereora College takes no responsibility for any items that may subsequently be lost or misplaced
- I / We understand that there is a NO CELLPHONE/HAND-HELD DEVICE in operation at Tereora College during school hours and if seen or heard, the device will be confiscated and will be picked up by parents/caregivers only. I / We agree that cellphones, I-Pads and the like are brought to school at the risk of my child and that the school does not take responsibility for the loss, damage or theft of these personal items.
- I / We give permission for Tereora College to obtain school records and any other information relevant to my child’s welfare from previous schools
- I / We attest that my child will have a current driver’s license when using their own transport to come to and from school
- I / We understand that there is an expected level of attendance needed to keep my enrolment current ($\geq 80\%$)

Students leaving school during the day: The school is responsible for students’ actions, health and safety during school hours. No pass will be issued without parent / caregiver consent. A student wishing to leave school during the school day must get a student pass from the school office. A pass will only be issued for a valid reason.

Standard Dress Code Requirement

(i) Uniform

Girls' Uniform

- Navy blue A-line skirt - below knee cap
- White collared short sleeved blouse with Tereora College emblem on the pocket
- Fluorescent bras are not permitted
- No coloured tee-shirts are to be worn under the school blouse
- No tee-shirts or shirts of any kind are to be worn over the school uniform
- Girls must not let any shorts be shown below their skirts

Boys' Uniform

- Drill navy blue shorts above the knees (underwear is not be seen protruding)
- White collared shorts sleeved shirts with Tereora College emblem on the pocket
- No tee-shirt or shirt of any kind is to be worn over the school uniform
- No coloured undergarment is to be worn under the school shirt
- No tee-shirts must be seen below the school shirt sleeves or shirt bottom
- Bold, brightly coloured rugby-type socks are not to be worn

(ii) Kia Orana Wear

- a) Girls - Pareu dress which may or may not have sleeves. Alternatively, girls may wear a skirt and top as long as both items are in pareu wear although they do not have to match.
- b) Boys - Pareu shirt with school shorts

(iii) Make-up

NO make-up is to be worn including nail polish

(iv) Hair

- a) Girls with long or shoulder length hair to be plaited. Dyed hair that looks unnatural is unacceptable.
- b) Boys hair to be neatly trimmed and must not be below the shirt collar. Boys must not have "outrageous" hairstyles or use unnatural hair dye. Facial hair to be removed and sideburns kept to an acceptable length.

(v) Jewellery

- NO jewellery is to be worn by boys with the exception of a wrist watch
- Girls may wear one small plain sleeper or stud in each ear - the stud must be small and subtle
- Religious or cultural necklaces are not permitted

(vi) Mufti Wear

- Girls and boys should wear respectable casual wear that will not cause offence. Boys are not permitted to wear wrap around pareu wear

(vii) College Jackets & College Hoodies

- These are the only outer garments that can be worn on the top half of the body. No other jersey, jackets etc are allowed.

(viii) Helmets

- ALL STUDENTS who travel to and from school on motorbikes or scooters are expected to wear an approved helmet. This includes pillion passengers.
